COMATA entrusts PIRIOU with the building of new 63m longliner



COMATA just confirmed to PIRIOU the order of a 62.8m freezer dedicated to toothfish fishing in the French Austral seas.

Designed by PIRIOU INGENIERIE and built in the Vietnamese PIRIOU shipyard, "Ile de la Reunion" should be delivered by the end of the 2018 summer.

It will be equipped with a Diesel electric propulsion made of two propulsion systems allowing more flexibility in energy management, a simplified maintenance and fuel oil savings. The electric production comes from four marine diesel oil (MDO) powered generators.

Designed to be operated in first category tropical zones, especially in the Indian Ocean, as well as in the south subpolar region up to a latitude under 60°S, "I'lle de la Reunion" is "ICE 1C" classified.

In order to be able to operate in "zero reject" areas, this last generation longliner is also equipped with a treatment plant for fishing waste: waste is ground and stored in two dedicated tanks of 95 m³ total capacity.



With this order, COMATA and the SCAPECHE group renew confidence of nearly 20 years with the building of three 46m offshore trawlers between 2003 and 2005 and a 55.45m longliner in 2002 named "Ile de la Reunion".

Vincent FAUJOUR, PIRIOU CEO, declares "We are proud and glad to go on with a long-standing collaboration with COMATA and the SCAPECHE group.

With this new last generation longliner, we keep supporting our customers in renewing their fleet for toothfish fishing in the EEZs (Exclusive Economic Zones) of the French Austral and Antarctic Territories".
