PIRIOU delivers new 16m trawler TELEMAQUE to shipowner Jean-Baptiste MARION



PIRIOU delivered to shipowner Jean-Baptiste MARION new generation 16m trawler TELEMAQUE. Dedicated to scallop fishing and trawling in the Channel, it will have home port in Grandcamp-Maisy - Normandy- as for the previous TELEMAQUE.

Ordered in July 2018, this trawler is the outcome of a close cooperation between shipowner Jean-Baptiste MARION and PIRIOU as the builder. PIRIOU outsourced the design and support for this project to naval architecture firm COPREXMA and its renowned expertise in this type of vessel.

TELEMAQUE is a very silent and stable vessel answering the customer's demand which required heavy sound insulation and better seakeeping behaviour. Inverted bow improves crew comfort and increases both volume under the bridge and speed without increasing consumption.

PIRIOU C.E.O. Vincent FAUJOUR said: 'PIRIOU confirms through this new contract, its willingness to stay on this historical market that remains very important for the group. This delivery is an opportunity to take part in the renewal of the French artisanal fishing fleet. This project was achieved by a small-close team, organized to manage efficiently and competitively this type of building while also dealing with current maintenance of vessels such as the first TELEMAQUE of shipowner Jean-Baptiste MARION. Once again, previously existing trust-based relationship—since 2007—led to the building of a new unit'.
